Cowell Wetland Project

The next steps for this project will be new curbing and a footpath along the Esplanade side of this space, installation of a very substantial subsurface irrigation system, some areas of lawn, two footbridges, and a series of paths.

A big feature of this area will be the plants, of which there are approximately 7000 to go in.

This is a tough environment in which to establish plants so to give the plants the very best opportunity to survive we will be staging the planting over a



6-8 month period. In late October we were lucky enough to get some much appreciated assistance from the Cowell Area School in planting the first 800 plants. We had students from Years 5,6 & 7, and some teachers including the Principal. This was a great example of both community involvement and of "many hands make light work". In less than 3 hours this group of enthusiastic volunteers had all of the plants in. The tangle of irrigation lines currently around the first lagoon are temporary only, while we get this first batch of plants going.

This area will be relatively slow to establish as we wait for the plants to grow but will ultimately be a stunning addition to our foreshore as it becomes established.



HOUSING OCCUPANCY REQUIREMENTS

From 1 January 2024 a class 1a house must not be occupied unless it is fully completed to a standard suitable for ongoing occupancy and will require a Certificate of Occupancy prior to occupation.

The elements currently under consideration to ensure occupant safety are:

- · structurally sound and weatherproof
- have a working kitchen, bathroom and laundry
- have relevant services connected eg electricity, water
- · have all smoke alarms installed and tested

Camping Around Franklin Harbour

To book a site within the District Council of Franklin Harbour permits must be obtained online at www.eyrepeninsula.com/camping.

All campers must have self contained toilet facilities except where toilet facilities are provided.
