Please provide a description of the regulated Retail Services currently offered, as specified on the Pricing Schedule.	Water - The District Council of Franklin Harbour provides the Port Gibbon and Lucky Bay shack settlements with their water supply. Council also provides a group of farmers in the Coolanie area with potable water via an SA water connection. CWMS - Council provides Port Gibbon and the township of Cowell with Community Wastewater Management Schemes
Please provide information on how the current pricing policies have been developed.	Prices calculated for water are based on full cost recovery and are being reviewed each year. Costs of maintaining the water supply at Port Gibbon, Lucky Bay and Coolanie are shared amongst the users with pricing being reviewed on an annual basis to ensure full cost recovery. The costs of maintaining the Port Gibbon CWMS is divided equally between the users of the service. The service charge for the Cowell CWMS was reduced to assist with ratepayers paying the connection costs. Council has decided that a phasing in strategy needs to be employed to return the service charge to the level required to recoup the whole of life costs of the Cowell CWMS. This is now being increased by \$50 +CPI per annum
Please describe the rationale for the price movements between the 2022-23 and 2023-24	in addition to the above information, Port Gibbon and Lucky Bay water usage accounts are charged at the kilolitre rates charged by SA Water.
