Notice of Dredging Works

Lucky Bay Harbour & Entrance Channel

(Extraction of material in harbour, harbour mouth and channel)

Sea Management Corporation Services Pty Ltd ('SMCS') gives notice that dredging operations on the Lucky Bay Harbour and entrance channel will be commencing on or around **Thursday 21 November 2019**.

Dredging will occur in accordance with the Development Approval for the Lucky Bay Harbour (Development Approval 49/922/003/05 and Development Approval 922/V001/2013) which require the owner of the harbour to dredge the harbour and channel on a regular basis and the EPA Licence for the dredging (EPA Licence 33162).

In the upcoming campaign, dredging will occur by the raking of seaweed using a harrow attached to a vessel. Raked seagrass wrack will remain in the water and will be pulled outwards along, and to the sides of, the channel.

A Dredging (and Marine Excavation) Management and Monitoring Plan (the Plan) has been prepared. This plan forms part of the EPA Licence and dredging will be undertaken in accordance with the Plan. The plan sets out measures that will be followed to ensure the dredging does not result in environmental harm. The measures include, but are not limited to, advance monitoring of meteorological conditions, monitoring of turbidity and dissolved oxygen in the water during dredging, slowing or ceasing activities if stated criteria are exceeded and the appropriate management of dredged material.

Dredging will also occur in a manner consistent Sand and Seagrass Management Plans authorised by the Coast Protection Board (CPB) pursuant to conditions of Development Approval 49/922/003/05.

Dredging may occur seven days per week between the hours of 7.00am and 6.00pm.

Copies of the Licence, the Dredging (and Marine Excavation) Management and Monitoring Plan and the Sand and Seagrass Management Plans will be located, and available for inspection, at the Lucky Bay Ferry Terminal / Kiosk.
